Your New Tonganoxie Public Library Capital Giving Campaign

What will the funds be used for?

Tax-deductible contributions will be used to purchase additional book shelving, furniture, self-checkout and audiovisual equipment, laptops, and other fixtures throughout the building. The estimated cost of furniture and fixtures is \$175,000.

Why are these needs not funded by sales tax proceeds approved by voters?

The funding from the city, which was financed through bonds, is for the cost of the land and the construction of the building, which will be owned by the city. The Library is a tenant in the building and therefore the Library is responsible for buying the furniture and furnishings.

When will the new library be opened?

The projected opening date for the new, 10,000-square-foot library is March 2020.
